- Flexible start date
- Flexible combined non-ACGME clinical training (e.g. global health/thoracic anesthesiology fellowship)
- Up to 12 weeks working abroad
- A rigorous curriculum in medical anthropology including lectures, workshops, and seminars throughout the year
- Engagement with the United Nations and the Weill Cornell Center for Human Rights
- Clinical experience as an anesthesiology attending at NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital/ Weill Cornell Medical Center
