Eligible Applicants:

Applicants must have completed training in an ACGME-accredited program in anesthesiology. Both Board-Certified and Board-Eligible applicants are invited to apply. No prior international experience is required though a demonstrated interest in global health should be exhibited.

Please have the following ready before beginning the application:

1. Personal Statement (limit 1,000 words). Please discuss your interest in global health and prior experience, countries of interest (or state flexibility), research interest areas, and plans after graduation from fellowship.
2. Curriculum Vitae
3. Three letters of recommendation (one from Residency Program Director)
4. Copy of USMLE scores
5. ITE scores

Applications are due by January 31.

International Applicants:

We welcome international applications for the fellowship program. The USMLE is a requirement for international applicants and exceptions cannot be made, given that candidates must be eligible for an unrestricted medical license in order to participate in the operating room experience as an attending anesthesiologist.
